

Nomination Guidelines



Please read all instructions carefully to ensure that you understand the nomination process and all requirements for a “completed” application. Nomination Application Deadline: July 31, 2017, 5:00pm.

- Applications must be complete and delivered to the Heritage Mississauga office no later than 5:00pm on **July 31, 2017.**
- Only one nomination per form.
- No late or incomplete applications will be accepted. Heritage Mississauga is not responsible for lost applications; please call to confirm your application has been received at the office.

Nomination Guidelines

- When filling out the nomination package please provide as much detail as possible on the nominee. The judging will be based solely on the material you provide.

Eligibility

- Current Board of Directors and staff of Heritage Mississauga, members of the awards jury, and committee members are not eligible to be nominated. Staff are also not eligible to nominate candidates.
- Nominator must be at least 18 years of age and may not be a family member of the nominee.
- Nominee must be a resident or work in the city of Mississauga.

Criteria

- Nominations will be judged on their merit & how well they fit the award framework included in this package.

Selection

- Winners will be selected by a Jury of 3-5 members of the community. Their decision will be considered final. It is at the discretion of the Jury to select a winner in each category.
- Winners will be announced at the Credits on Thursday October 12th, 2017.
