### Richard Collins

**Richard** has been active in enlivening, preserving and celebrating Mississauga's past, present and future since 1999. A natural storyteller, Richard has been a tour guide for Benares Historic House, Bradley Museum and the Port Credit BIA. He's a member of the Mississauga South Historical Society and Thompson's Company 2<sup>nd</sup> York Militia, and he's written articles about Mississauga's history for the Streetsville Booster, Heritage News, and the Port Credit Mineola Neighbours Magazine. Charles received the Queen's Golden and Diamond Jubilee Medals in recognition for his service to the community and was inducted as a Commander to the Order of Merit in Portugal.
