All other pertinent information will be provided upon acceptance into the exhibition. **Canopies must be anchored in case of wind (this will be checked at set up). Canopies will not be provided by Heritage Mississauga.**

EXHIBITOR SET-UP AND TAKE DOWN

Artists must arrive between **9 am and 10 am** on Saturday for set up. Artists must not dismantle their display or commence packing until the event closes.

DEMONSTRATIONS

Artists are asked to demonstrate their talents during the event. Bring a piece that you are working on and talk to the public about your work.
