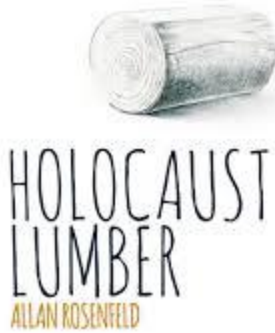

Port Credit Community Foundation

The Port Credit Foundation was created to strengthen and enhance the quality of life in the Port Credit community using a \$3 million endowment from FRAM Building Group and Slokker Real Estate Group as part of the developer's contribution to underwriting community amenities in the local area. The Foundation has contributed to many local festivals and events including Canada Day - Paint the Town Red; Busker Fest and Port Credit 175 Celebration.



Dr. Alan Rosenfeld

Alan Rosenfeld is the son of two Holocaust survivors who immigrated to Canada with his older brother in 1951 after they met in a displaced persons camp in 1945. Both parents were the sole survivors of their respective families. Alan's memories of growing up in this unique immigrant family while working in the family's lumber yard in Malton are recorded in his book Holocaust Lumber. They give a whole new perspective to immigration and the new immigrant experience.



Small Arms Society

The **Small Arms Society (SMS)** is a leader in the initiative to revitalise the historic Small Arms Munitions Plant in Lakeview as a creative hub of workshops, learning labs, galleries and studio spaces. Although in its infancy, the society has great plans to develop the building over the next few years. A prime example was the IN SITU Multi Arts & Heritage Festival held in October 2016.
